The top three male and female qualifiers in each official North Carolina Senior Games sport/event in each age category will be eligible to participate in State Finals, including bowling: • Golfers must meet a minimum performance score (MPS) and finish 1, 2 or 3 to qualify. • All participants who complete a Local Games Fun Walk, Football Throw, Softball Throw and Basketball Shooting will qualify. • Teams: The first, second and third place teams per the team sport age category will qualify. • In SilverArts, each Local Games may qualify: a. One entry in Performing Arts and the Cheerleader Showcase. b. First and second place in each Literary Arts sub-category, provided the places are not won by the same artist. c. First, second and third place entry in each Visual Arts and Heritage Arts subcategory, provided the places are not won by the same artist (i.e. only one entry by the same artist per sub-category) MPS is available from your Coordinator and in the NCSG Rules Book on the NCSG site (www.ncseniorgames.org)

It is each participant's individual responsibility to check with their Local Senior Games Coordinator immediately following the Local Senior Games to determine if they have qualified for State Finals and to get a State Finals Entry Packet. The State Finals registration form with payment and all required items must be received in the NCSG office in Raleigh by 11:59pm on August 1, 2025. GENERAL INFORMATION CONT'D

AGE CATEGORIES / ELIGIBILITY

A participant's age on December 31, 2025 determines the age category in which they will compete. Men and women compete in separate categories in the following five (5) year age groups: 50 - 54, 55 -59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+.

For doubles and team events:

- 1) the category will be determined by age of the youngest participant;
- 2) for those qualifying, partners and teams must remain the same for state and national competition.

To be eligible to participate in the Rockingham County Senior Games, an individual must be 50 or better by December 31, 2025.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Participant completes and signs the entry form and submits with total payment by 5pm on March 31, 2025. (NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED)
- Check-in will begin at your first event.
 Participants must check-in 15 minutes prior to competing in his or her first event (including all Tournament and Golf events).

Start time is forfeit time for local, state and national games!

GOLF INFORMATION

Only athletes meeting the following minimum performance standards *in addition* to finishing 1, 2, or 3 at the local level will qualify to participate in golf at State Finals.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

All brackets will be drawn prior to the event and adjusted as needed by day-of-event attendance. Participants who do not check in by the scheduled starting time will forfeit that event. INCLEMENT WEATHER

The decision to continue, delay or reschedule an event due to inclement weather will be made by the Rockingham County Games Events Director. Art will remain on exhibit until Friday, May 30th Artists must pick up their artwork by 4:00pm on May 30th On May 30th all participants are encouraged to take artwork to the Eden Public Library for additional display time through the month of June.

Limit—1 entry per sub-category

HERITAGE ARTS

Sub-Categories:

Basket Weaving, ** Ceramics, **China Painting, Crocheting, ** Doll Making, Jewelry, Knitting,

**Miscellaneous, Needlework, Pottery (hand built or thrown), Quilting (hand stitched), Quilting (machine stitched), **Rugs (hooked, braided, woven), Stained Glass, **Tatting & Needle lace, Tole & Decorative Painting, Weaving, Woodcarving, Woodturning, and Woodworking. An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals; except in Performing Arts - an artist may only have one (1) entry per size of Act in each sub-category.

Each Local Games may send/submit a <u>first</u> and <u>second</u> place qualifier in each Literary Arts sub-category; <u>one</u> Act/entry in Performing Arts and Cheerleading to State Finals; and the <u>first</u>, <u>second</u> and <u>third</u> place qualifiers in each Heritage and Visual Arts sub-category. A participant may only submit one entry per sub-category. The Local Game may determine how to choose the Performing Act to represent their Game at State Finals.

NCSG will judge SilverArts at State Finals. Medals will be awarded in each sub-category in Visual, Literary, and Heritage Arts. Medals in Performing Arts will be awarded to solo, small group (2 - 4 performers), and large group (5 or more performers) in each sub-category.

The SilverArts entry/entries entered at State Finals **must be the same** entry/entries that won in the Local Games competition.

Entries must be the <u>original</u> work of the artist and must have been completed within 2 years of the Local Games' qualifying date.

An art entry may only be entered in one (1) SilverArts subcategory at State Finals.

Artists must not submit an entry if the piece/performance/ entry has been showcased in the previous SilverArts Showcase at State Finals.

Art entry/entries incorrectly categorized by the artist, or not in compliance with NCSG Guidelines and Category Requirements, will not be considered in the judging process

VISUAL ARTS

<u>Sub-categories:</u> Acrylics, Drawing, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastels, Photography, Sculpture, Watercolor

All artwork, except sculpture, must be framed, securely wired, and ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Artwork, except sculpture, not properly wired will not be displayed.

- Artwork, except sculpture, can be no larger than 36" x
 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- Sculpture groupings (sets) may have no more than 3 pieces per grouping (set).
- Mixed media may be a freestanding piece.
- Freestanding entries must be able to be displayed in an area 3' (W) x 3' (L) x 5' (Height)
- Artists, or their representatives, are responsible to deliver and pick-up their entry at/during the designated times.
- If on-site assembly is required, details must be specified on the Information Form for NCSG prior approval.
- The art piece must be an original work, not a print.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- Artist must send a photograph of entry with State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. Photos cannot be returned.
- The visual arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.
- The Visual Arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.

LITERARY ARTS

<u>Sub-category:</u> Essay, Life Experience, Poem, Short Story-Fiction

- All entries must be typed, formatted for 8-1/2 x 11 paper and have a minimum of 1" margins. A minimum font size is 10-point type.
- Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
- Short stories, essays, and life experiences can be no longer than
 8 pages.
- All entries must have a title page, which includes title of work, sub-category, and name of artist.
- Artist's name should not appear on the content pages.
- The literary arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.
- A display-quality copy of the winning Literary Arts entries, and three (3) additional photocopies, should be submitted to NCSG by the artist with their official State Finals Entry Form and Silver Arts Information Form.

PERFORMING ARTS Friday May 23, 2025 at 11:00am—First Presbyterian Church, 582 Southwood Drive, Eden, NC

<u>Sub-Categories:</u> Comedy/Drama, Dance, Instrumental, Line dance, Vocal

<u>Format/Rules:</u> Performing entries may be the following:

Soloist

Small Group (2- 4 performers) Large Group (5- 20 performers)

YOU MAY ONLY ENTER 3 ACTS TOTAL AND ONLY ONE IN EACH SUB-CATEGORY—YOU CANNOT COMPETE AGAINST YOURSELF.

- Performing entries are limited to 3 minutes of <u>on-stage</u> time.
 Exceeding the time limit will result in automatic disqualification. Timing begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the exit of the last performer from the stage or final movement of the act.
 Cheerleader acts will be allowed a maximum of 4 minutes of performance time
- Performing entries may be one of the following:(a) soloists, (b) small groups (2 4 performers), or (c) large groups (5 –20 performers). Accompanist(s) will be counted to determine size of act. No one under age 50 as of December 31st will be permitted on stage and an accompanist must be a registered participant.
- Rockingham County Senior Games can only provide a sound system with microphones (3 maximum) and chairs. Please spec-

- ify what you need. You are responsible for all other equipment and props (including music stands, tables, etc.). Provide very specific details on size, weight, etc. Props must be small, few, lightweight, and easy to set up quickly.
- If your act requires additional props/technical equipment, you must attach a list of all other props & technical equipment you plan to bring.
- At State Finals, all performers for all acts must enter stage right and exit stage left or begin and end on the stage. See the Silver Arts Manual for a stage diagram.
- If recorded music is used, the artist/group leader must provide to NCSG by August 1st or by the Early Bird Deadline July 1st, (with State Finals Entry Form and Silver Arts Information Form) a high-quality CD for their performance. No recorded instruction is permitted. Artists should pick up their music after the performance or it will not be mailed/returned. Their music/song should be the only music on the CD.
- At State Finals, NCSG can provide the following items: Microphone(s), Piano, Sound system, and CD player. The act is responsible for all other props and equipment (including music stands, chairs, etc.) and must get NCSG advance approval for use at Show.
- Voice presentations must be a *live* performance by the artist.
 Background music can be recorded. Lip-synch is not permitted as a performing art.
- The Group Leader, who must be a participant, must complete
 the Silver Arts Information Form for the group and submit it
 with their State Finals Entry Form, and each member of the
 group must submit their own personal State Finals Entry Form
 by the August 1st deadline.
- The performance at State Finals <u>must</u> <u>be</u> <u>the</u> <u>same</u> <u>performance</u> that won at the Local Games; i.e. same song, dance, music, etc.
- No live animals are allowed, except for service animals

**Performing Arts Rehearsal will be held on Thursday, May 22nd at 11am at First Presbyterian Church, 582 Southwood Drive, Eden, NC 27288.

This is <u>MANDATORY</u> for at least one person in the act that can bring the music for the act and any other props that may be needed.
